Ground Rules

Respecting Wildlife

At Kuti Wildlife Reserve, the safety of both our guests and the animals is our top priority. To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone, please follow these guidelines when encountering wildlife:

- **Keep your distance:** observe animals from a safe distance. Avoid approaching, feeding, or touching any wildlife, as this can disrupt their natural behavior and put both you and the animals at risk.
- **Stay quiet and calm:** wildlife is easily startled by loud noises or sudden movements. Keep your voice low and avoid making unnecessary noise while exploring the reserve.
- **Do not feed the animals:** feeding wildlife can harm their health and make them dependent on human food. It also increases the risk of unwanted animal encounters in visitor areas.
- **Follow your guide's instructions:** if you are on a guided tour, always listen to your guide. They are trained to keep you safe and ensure the well-being of the animals.
- **Stick to designated paths:** for your safety and to minimize the impact on the environment, stay on marked trails and avoid entering restricted areas.
- **Respect the environment:** take nothing but memories and leave nothing but footprints. Avoid littering and help us keep the reserve pristine for future visitors and the animals that call it home.

By following these simple rules, you help us protect the incredible biodiversity of Kuti Wildlife Reserve and ensure its preservation for generations to come.

Protecting Nature: our commitment to a clean and pristine reserve

At Kuti Wildlife Reserve, we strive to maintain a healthy and unspoiled environment for the incredible wildlife and natural beauty that surrounds us. To help us preserve this special place, we kindly ask you to follow these guidelines:

- **No littering:** please dispose of all waste in the designated bins provided throughout the reserve. Littering not only ruins the natural beauty of the area but can also pose serious threats to wildlife, as animals may ingest or become entangled in waste materials.
- **Avoid pollution:** help us keep Kuti clean by refraining from using plastic bags and other single-use items during your visit. Consider bringing reusable bottles and containers to minimize waste. Your small steps make a big difference in reducing pollution.
- **Leave flora and fauna undisturbed:** the plants and animals within the reserve are essential to the delicate ecosystem we work so hard to protect. Please do not pick flowers, collect plants, or remove any natural items, such as rocks or shells. Even small disruptions can have lasting effects on the environment.

Together, we can protect this haven of biodiversity and keep it thriving for years to come. Thank you for playing your part in conserving Kuti Wildlife Reserve.



Stick to the paths: protecting nature and staying safe

At Kuti Wildlife Reserve, the marked paths are there to guide you safely through the natural beauty of the area while minimizing your impact on the environment. Staying on designated trails helps us protect the delicate ecosystems and ensures you can enjoy the reserve responsibly.

Each path has a name sign. Check the map attached in the e-book for directions. Be aware that some roads are 4 x 4 only due to the sand. Maximum speed in the reserve is 20 kilometres per hour.

At Kuti Wildlife Reserve, our team is ready to assist if you find yourself stuck in the sand. However, please note that a fee may apply for this service. The exact cost will depend on the circumstances leading to the situation and will be determined at the time of assistance. We encourage all visitors to drive cautiously and adhere to reserve guidelines to avoid such incidents.

By sticking to the paths:

- You stay safe from potential hazards, such as hidden wildlife or uneven terrain.
- You protect the environment by avoiding damage to plants, habitats, and soil.
- You help preserve wildlife by minimizing disturbance to animals in their natural habitat.

Please respect the boundaries and signage throughout the reserve. Together, we can ensure that Kuti remains a sanctuary for both its wildlife and its visitors.

The solar system provides essential power for lighting and basic needs, but appliances like fans and refrigerators may not always operate at full capacity, especially during periods of high demand or limited sunlight. Guests are encouraged to plan accordingly and embrace the simplicity of life in nature.

Supporting Kuti Wildlife Reserve

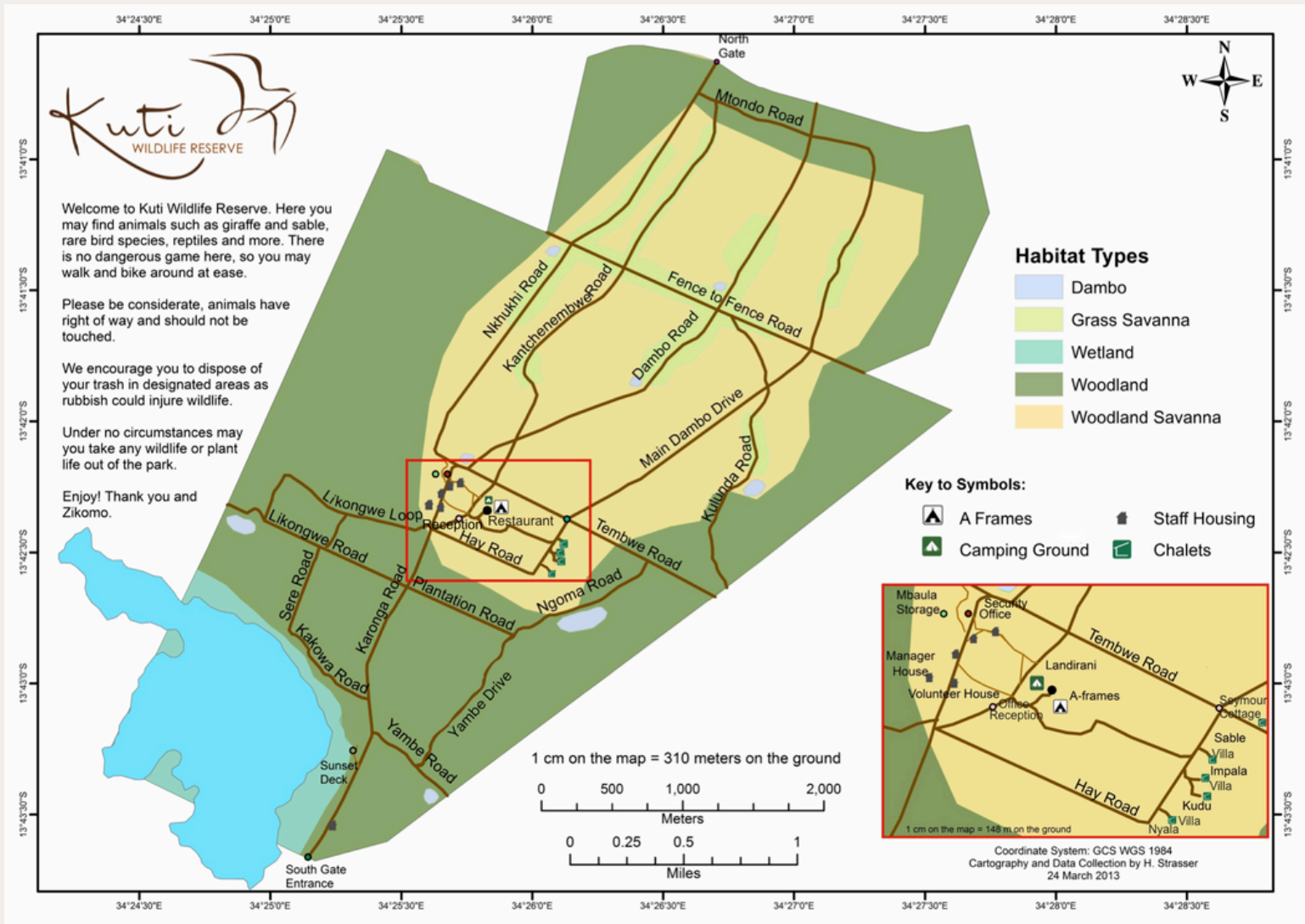
